Update: Anti-Bullying External Review – July 2024

In July 2024, I commissioned an external review of the school's new anti-bullying process that was launched in January 2024, including the new thresholds system that is designed to tackle any forms of unkind behaviour, before it becomes bullying. I am pleased to inform parents that the findings were positive with students informing the external visitor that the changes have been appreciated. Some student voice headlines include:

- 'Students say the school has improved over the past year. They feel much safer and are no longer being bullied. This is because clear sanctions are in place and systems for dealing with bullying.' (Anti-bullying Review, July 2024)
- 'Students understand the protected characteristics.' (Anti-bullying Review, July 2024)
- 'Students understand The Eckington Way' (Anti-bullying Review, July 2024)

Whilst these findings are pleasing, we will continue improving the school's anti-bullying campaign, and the school's new behaviour systems to ensure any form of unkind behaviour is dealt with in a timely manner.
